



## Council Elections

Amendments to the College's bylaws in 2009 have resulted in changes to the nomination process for positions on Council. Beginning in 2010 Council nominations are required 60 days in advance of the election, nominations from the AGM floor are no longer permitted.

For the 2010 elections, the deadline for submitting completed nomination packages to the College office was March 29, 2010.

Profiles of each Council candidate will be made available to practitioners on the College website beginning April 15, 2010.

## Labour Mobility Update

Canadian Paramedic Regulators are pleased to announce the appointment of Ben Maartman to the position of Project Director to manage the national two-year Labour Mobility Project recently approved for funding by the federal government.

Most recently Ben has been working with both the Alberta and British Columbia regulators to implement the Trade, Investment and Labour Mobility Agreement as it applies to the regulation of paramedics.

Nationally the regulators intend to build on previous work to confirm interprovincial scopes of practice and corresponding competency standards for four levels of practice.
